North Branch Works (NBW) strongly supports the industrial warehouse project proposed by Western George LLC for the property located at 2900 N Western Avenue.

It is exciting to see an industrial project proposed that is consistent with the underlying zoning and would bring forty to fifty high-quality jobs to the North Branch. Industrial jobs on average pay \$84,000 plus benefits, build community wealth, and strengthen the local economy.

The property is in the Addison Industrial Corridor. We are especially encouraged by the incredible economic development benefits the project would generate for the neighborhood, namely a \$14 million investment by the property owner, the creation of 40-50 high-quality jobs and up to 200 temporary construction jobs with 70% of these being union jobs.

The property owner met with us and is working closely with many stakeholders in the North Branch community. It is a pleasure to work with the property owner and his attorney.

NBW is a membership-based nonprofit organization that for over forty years has promoted balanced, job-creating economic development along the North Branch of the Chicago River. We are also a City of Chicago "delegate agency" providing a variety of support services to local businesses and property-owners.

We ask you to support this project so that it can proceed. NBW looks forward to the permits being issued for construction and supporting the property-owner as well as the two new businesses that plan to move into this property as they open operations in the North Branch.
