Project Scope

- Remove the existing bascule bridge over the **River** and replace with a fixed , but potentially movable, tied-arch bridge
- Remove the existing temporary bridge over the **Canal** and replace with a fixed thrust-arch bridge
- No detour. Run-a-round (diversion) will be used for both bridges
- Replacement of retaining walls
- Roadway widening by 4 to 6 feet
- Roadway improvement from I-90 to Cleveland Ave.
- New protected bike lanes
- Street lighting
- Traffic signals modernization (at 4 intersections)
- New traffic signal at Hickory Ave.
- Landscaping

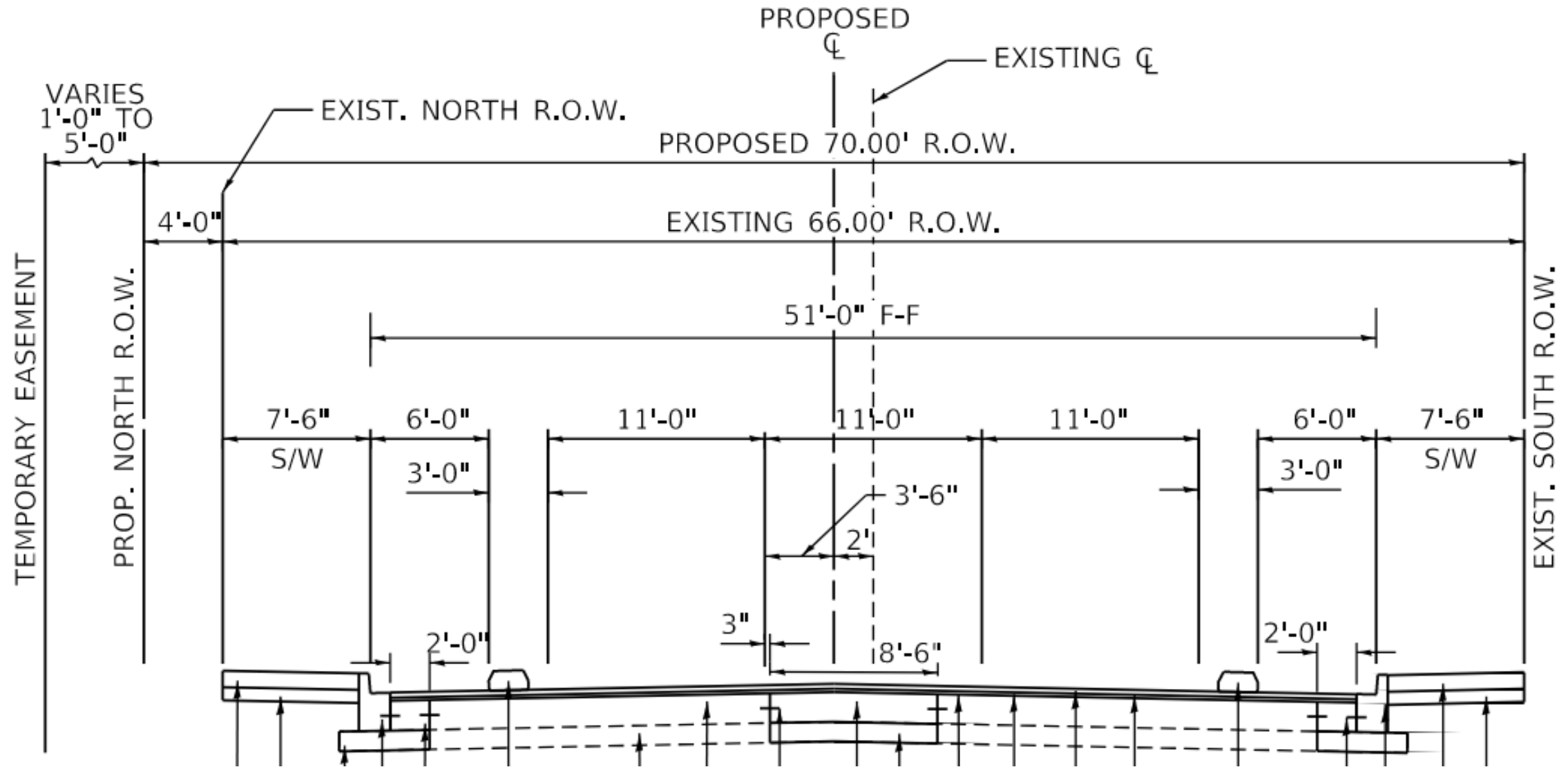

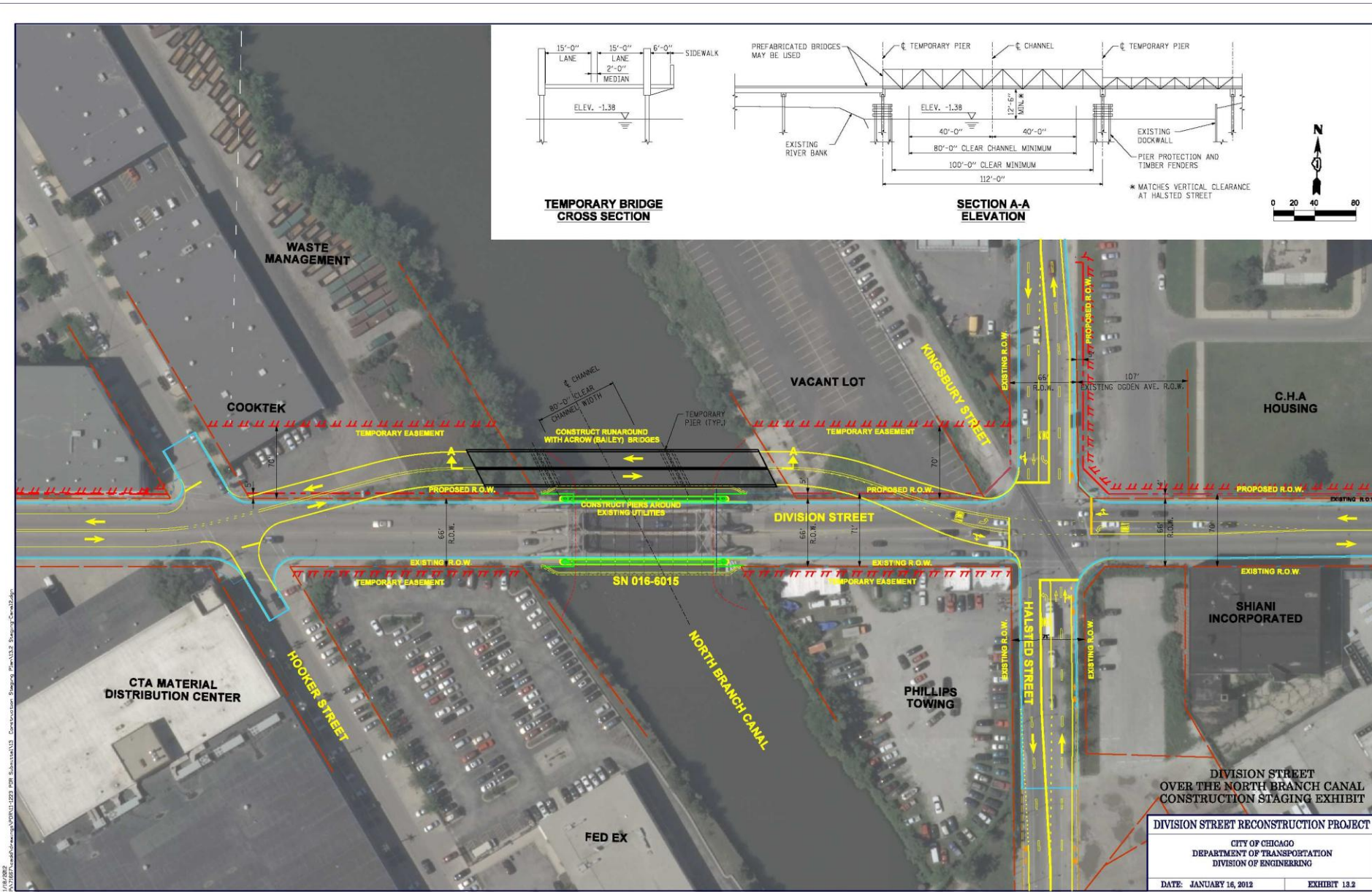

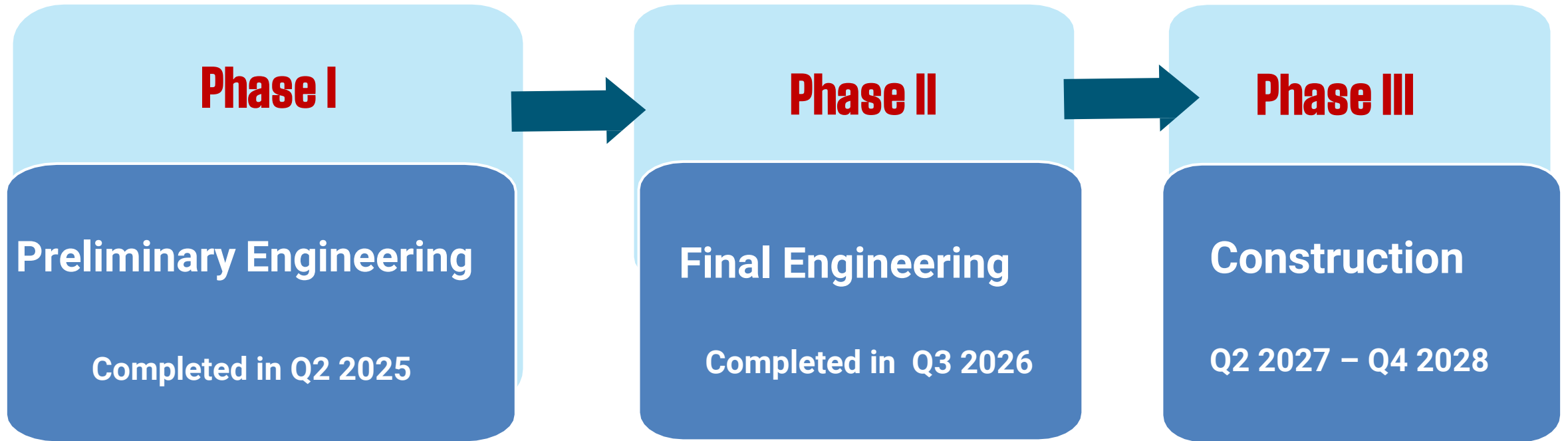
Typical Section – travel lanes and protected bike lanes
